Are your garden tools locked away?			
Does a trusted neighbour, relative or a friend have a key to your house in case of emergency?			
When you are not home, do you make it look like somebody is there by leaving on a light or radio?			
Do you avoid giving away personal details in person, in writing or through your answering machine message, such as who lives in your house, when you are going away on holidays etc?			
Do you have your emergency contact numbers keyed into your phone or on display nearby?
