

## Committee Nomination

Owners Corporations Act 2006 Section 103, Owners Corporations Regulations 2018 and Owners Corporation Rules OC 20 (12/07)

- A member of the committee must be a Lot Owner or be authorised by a Lot Owner (hold a proxy) to act on their behalf.
- A person is not eligible to be elected as a committee member if they are in arrears for any fees or other amounts are owed to the Owners Corporation.
- A nomination for a committee member where the lot is owned in the name of a company, must be made out in the name of the company, and be accompanied by the enclosed proxy form with section B completed.
